

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FOR FALL 2020

Theatre Arlington will be following CDC guidelines, in addition to state and local mandates to keep our patrons, performers, staff and volunteers safe and healthy. These include, but may not be limited, to:

FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR PATRONS

- Patrons are asked NOT to attend if you are feeling unwell or are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19 or if you have had contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (within 14 days prior to performance). Please contact the box office for your options.
- Face Coverings ARE required for everyone to enter the theatre building.

Patron may only remove face covering to eat or drink, while seated *inside* the theatre.

- Entry to lobby will be monitored to allow for social distancing in the lobby. Patrons will not be allowed to enter until space is available.
- Patrons will be greeted outside by an usher and will enter through the middle front door and directed to the house manager for check-in and further instructions.
- Hand Sanitizing Stations will be available upon entering the lobby and at other designated locations.
- Patrons will maintain 6 feet from other groups/parties while inside lobby.

There will be markers on the floor to assist with social distancing.

- No loitering or gathering in the lobby will be allowed.
- Restrooms will be monitored to allow for social distancing and wiped down every 30 minutes.
- No gifts/flowers for performer will be allowed.
- Performers will be more than 6' from first row of patrons.
- No Performer Meet & Greet after the show.

Patrons may meet them outside of the theatre building.

- No more than 3 'groups' in box office line at a time.
- All patrons will exit through the side exit on Main Street, unless leaving from the restrooms.

SEATING & RESERVATIONS

- Due to limited seating capacity Reservations Strongly Suggested. If available, tickets may be purchased at door.
- Cabaret Series & Revues show time has been moved to 8:00pm. Doors will open at 7:30pm.
- Patrons from the same household may sit together.
- Patrons who are not from the same household BUT are attending together may sit together.
- There will be 2 seats blocked between each party/group.
- No seating in alternating rows (Rows B, D, F, H, K, M).
- Party must have all guests in attendance before being allowed to be seated.

(all members of party must be seated at same time)

- Late Seating MAY be allowed for Cabaret Series
- Seating Limit: 50% Capacity

BAR & CONCESSIONS

- Bar service will be open before and during the show.
 - Bar will utilize disposable glasses and containers.
 - NO Bar Service after show.
- Concessions will be open before and during the show. All items are pre-packaged.
- Credit/Debit Card preferred
 - Cash will be accepted, but please try to have exact amount. No change will be made.

THEATRE BUILDING & STAFF

- All staff and volunteers WILL wear Face Coverings at all times.
- All staff and volunteers will wash hands/use hand sanitizer frequently.
- All spaces and surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each performance.
- A sanitizing mister will be used following each event. The mist coats all surfaces, soft and hard, and utilizes a hydrogen peroxide mixture which will dissipate before the next day.
- Surfaces and frequently touched areas will be wiped down every 30 minutes while guests are in the theatre.
- Patrons' ingress and egress will be very specific, clearly marked and unobstructed.
